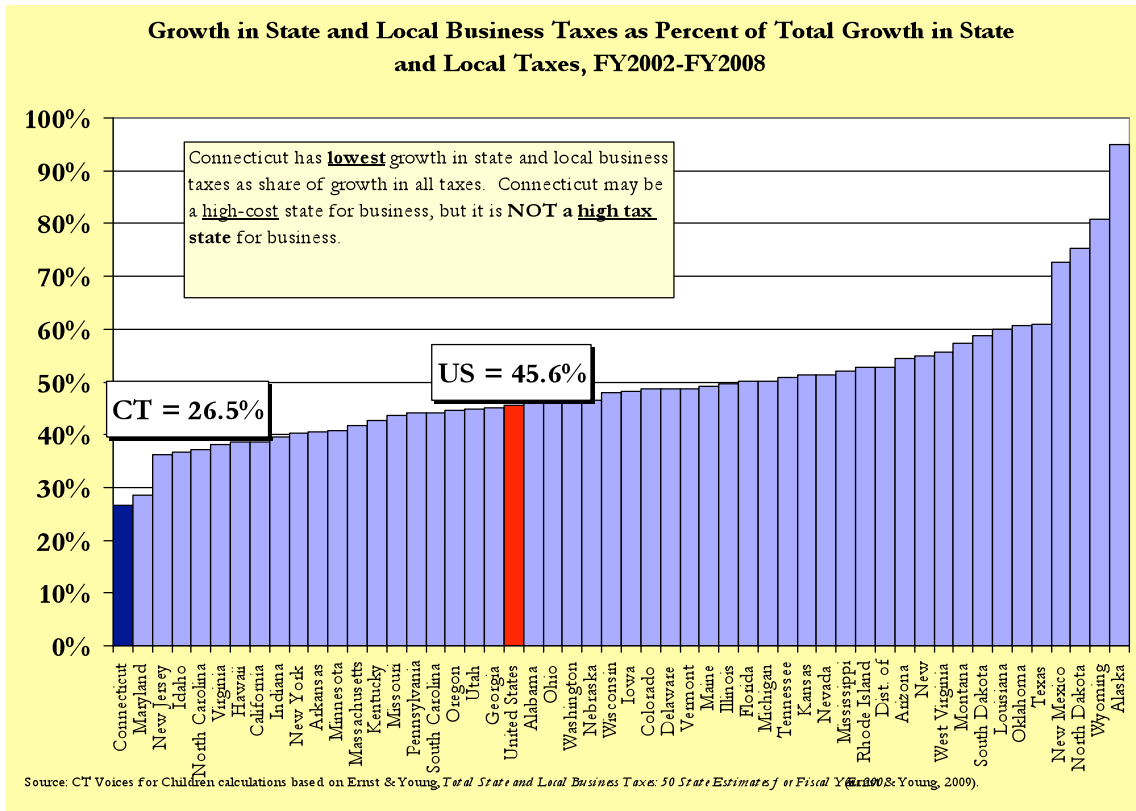


Tax Fact #3

CONNECTICUT HAS THE LOWEST BUSINESS TAX GROWTH IN THE NATION.



Connecticut corporate tax policy is a failure. It is time to raise revenue and invest in jobs. According to the Office of Fiscal Analysis, between the fiscal years of 1983 and 2006 total business tax revenues declined from 24% to just 7% of total General Fund revenues.

Using tax avoidance schemes more and more big corporations avoid paying corporate income taxes. Large profitable corporations need to **pay their fair share**.

Despite the slowest growth in total business taxes in the country Connecticut lags in job growth. It's time for a new approach with fair taxes and smart investments.
